2NR: I could tell.

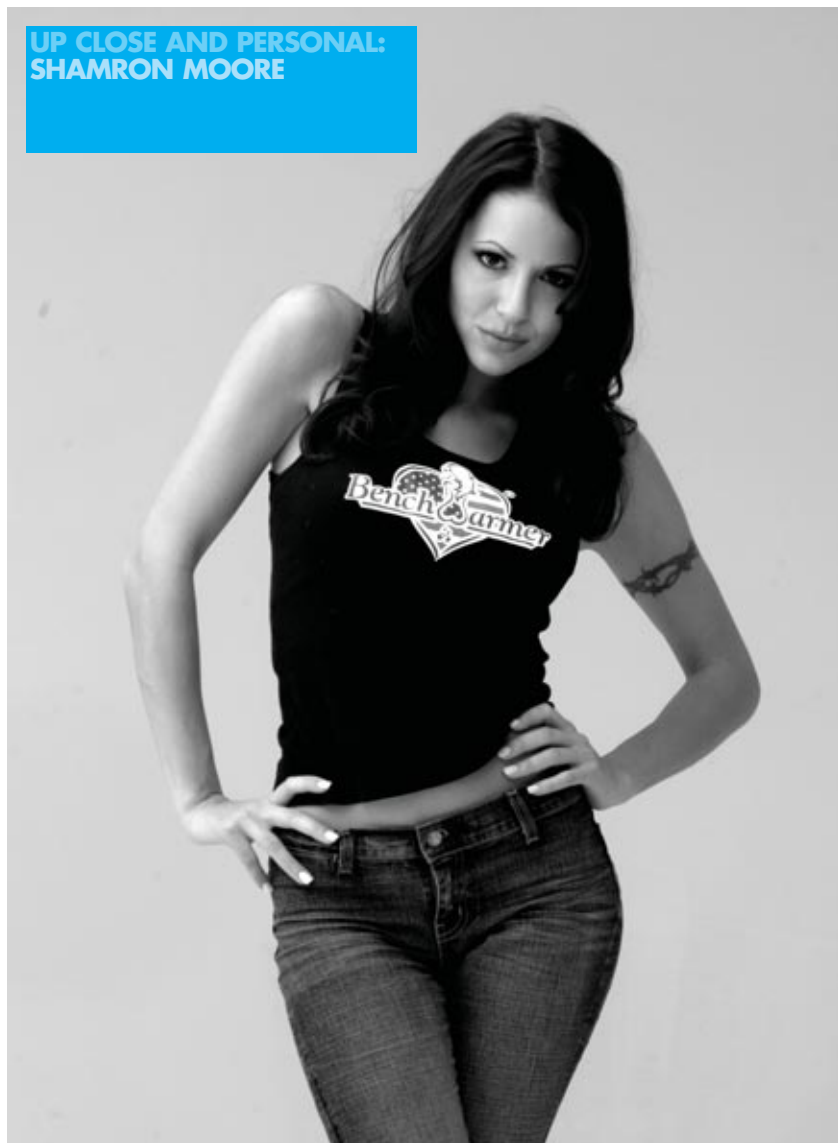
SM: How?
